Subject:

Rules for the Use of Municipal Resources During the Election Campaign Period

Pursuant to Section 88.18 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, municipalities and local boards shall establish rules and procedures with respect to the use of municipal or board resources during the election campaign period.

Restrictions

No candidate, third party advertiser or any other person or entity shall:

- use City resources, services, publications, events, assets, facilities, equipment, or property for election campaign purposes
- use the City's website, domain names, social media, other corporate systems, or City logo or other digital assets for election campaign purposes
- use the services of City employees for election campaign purposes during hours in which the employees are in the paid employment of the City

Notwithstanding the restrictions, election signs are permitted in locations as outlined in the City's Candidate and Third Party Advertiser Information and Nomination Packages.
