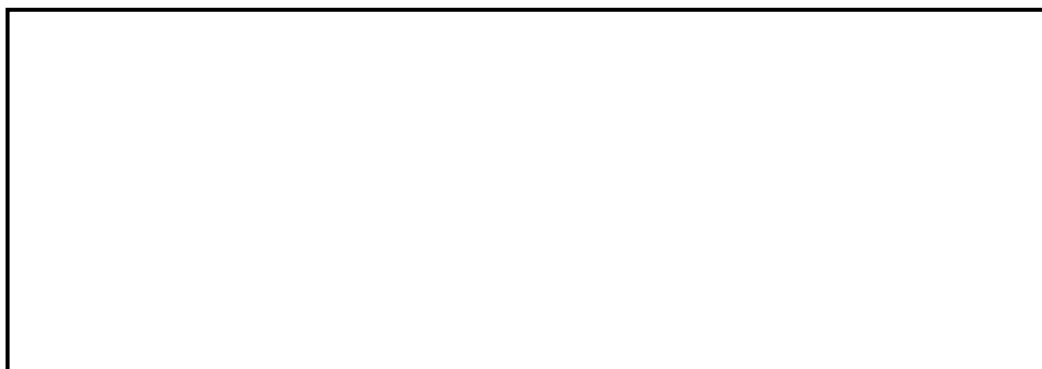
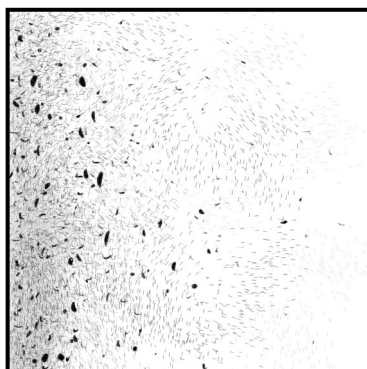


DRAWING TECHNIQUES

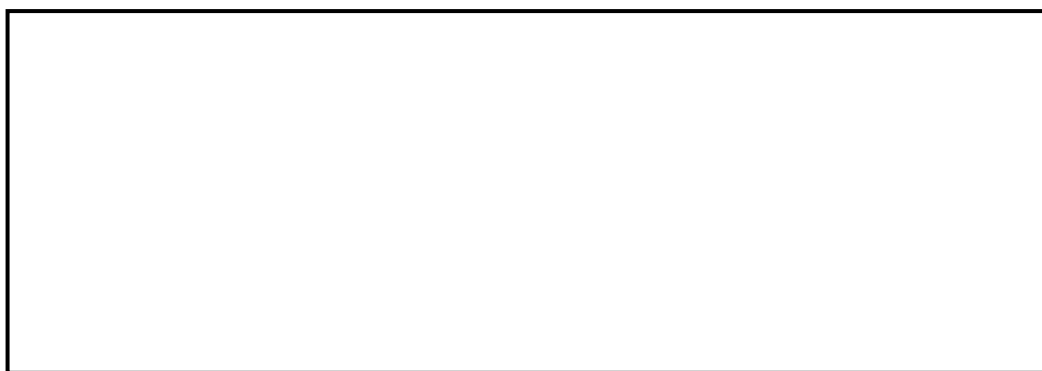
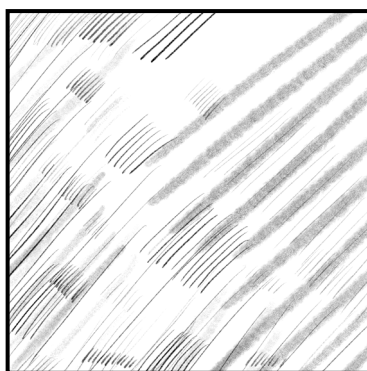
Creating texture, shading, & depth

Practice the drawing techniques.



STIPPLING

1. Make small dots beside one another to fill the box
2. Place the dots close together on one side of the box
3. As you move to the other side of the box, gradually allow the spaces between the dots to get bigger and farther apart
4. The closer together the dots, the darker the value; the farther away the dot from each other, the lighter the value



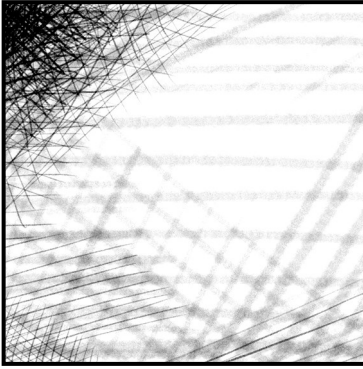
HATCHING

1. Make separate parallel lines to fill the box
2. Make some of the lines longer and some shorter
3. Draw some lines closer together for darker value
4. Draw other lines farther apart for lighter value

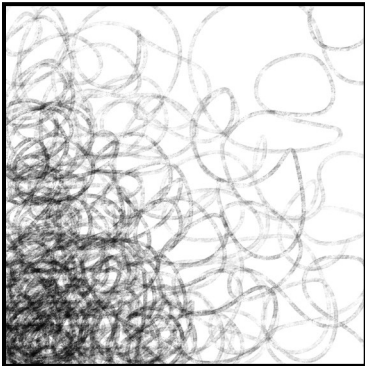

CROSS-HATCHING

1. Draw hatched lines in one direction
2. Then, draw another set of lines going in another direction
3. Keep drawing and overlapping lines in different directions to change the value



SCUMBLING

1. Without lifting your pencil, draw small, scribbly, curvy lines to fill the box
2. Build up layers and overlap lines to change the value
3. Change the size of the scribbles to change the value
