These are some of the items that do not go in your recycling bin

If an item is not listed below, please use the **WASTELINE APP** found on our website to search if an item is recyclable, household garbage, placed out for bulk item collection, or dropped off at the Enviro-Depot.

FIBERS BOX

Cardboard Items

- ✘ Coffee cups – Household garbage
- ✘ Waxed cardboard – Household garbage

Paper Items

- ✘ Carbon paper – Household garbage
- ✘ Coffee filters/Coffee grounds
- ✘ Construction paper – Household garbage
- ✘ Cotton Swabs
- ✘ Diapers – Household garbage
- ✘ Facial Tissues (Kleenex), paper towels: Used – Household garbage
- ✘ Hard covers on books – Household garbage If hard covers are removed; pages may go in recycling bin
- ✘ Metallic wrapping paper – Household garbage
- ✘ Paper drinking cups – Household garbage
- ✘ Tea bags
- ✘ Wallpaper – Household garbage
- ✘ Waxed paper, wax coated cups – Household garbage

CONTAINERS BOX

Glass/Plastic Items

- ✘ Aluminum foil (soiled)
- ✘ Automotive fluid/oil containers – Take to Enviro-Depot
- ✘ Boxboard - **Inner liners (wax paper, cereal box, etc.)**- Household garbage
- ✘ Bows & Ribbons
- ✘ Brake fluid containers – Take to Enviro-Depot
- ✘ Ceramics & drinking glasses
- ✘ Corrosive material bottles – Take to Enviro-Depot
- ✘ Foil wrapping paper – Household garbage
- ✘ Drink or Juice Pouches
- ✘ Garden multi cell containers – Household garbage
- ✘ Glass drinking cups – Household garbage
- ✘ Hairbrushes (Household garbage)
- ✘ Light bulbs, fluorescent bulbs, or tubes – Take to Enviro-Depot

CONTAINERS BOX – CONT'D

- ✘ Milk pouches – **inner bags are household garbage**
- ✘ Paper napkins (soiled)
- ✘ Pesticide or herbicide bottles – Take to Enviro-Depot
- ✘ Plastic litter boxes
- ✘ Plastic toys: **Small** – Household garbage / **Large** – Take to Enviro-Depot or Bulk Item Curbside Collection
- ✘ Plastic patio furniture – Take to Enviro-Depot or Bulk Item Curbside Collection
- ✘ Prescription bottles – Household garbage
- ✘ Saran wrap – Household garbage
- ✘ Stiff/crinkly type bags (potato chip bags, non-plastic department store bags) – Household garbage
- ✘ Straws – Household garbage
- ✘ Styrofoam cups & packaging nuts – Household garbage
- ✘ Styrofoam packaging materials – Take to the Recycling Depot on Clarke Street
- ✘ Transmission fluid and antifreeze containers – Take to Enviro-Depot
- ✘ Windows, window glass, mirror glass or any other broken glass – Take to Enviro-Depot

Metal Items

- ✘ Batteries – Collection bins at many City facilities or Enviro-Depot
- ✘ Metal that is not an empty food or beverage container, small metal bits/pieces, hangers – Enviro-Depot
- ✘ Utensils

Other Items

- ✘ Crockery/Ceramic (dishes, coffee mugs) – Household garbage
- ✘ String – Household garbage
- ✘ 1lb propane cylinders – Take to Enviro-Depot
- ✘ Syringes – Take to Enviro-Depot
- ✘ Wood – Take to Enviro-Depot
- ✘ Rubber – Take to Enviro-Depot - **EXCEPT car mats – these are household garbage**
