Article 1 - Short Title

477.1.1 Citation

This Chapter may be cited as the Public Nuisance By-law. By-law 6049-83, July 14, 1983.

Article 2 - Loitering

4 7 7 . 2 . 1 Prohibited - sidewalk - street - highway - public place

No person shall lounge, loaf, loiter or stand as an idler on any public sidewalk or street or highway or in any public place within the corporate boundaries of the City of Woodstock so as to obstruct the due and proper use thereof. By-law 5149-75, October 23, 1975. (See Set Fine)

Article 3 - Enforcement

477.3.1 Fine - for contravention

Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Chapter is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine or penalty as provided in the *Provincial Offences Act*. By-law 7139-94, June 2, 1994.
