Article 1 - General Provisions

817.1.1 **Removal of door - lock - required**

It shall be unlawful in the City of Woodstock for any person, firm or corporation to leave in an uninhabited building or outside of any building, structure or dwelling, or in any place accessible to children any abandoned, unattended or discarded icebox, refrigerator or any other container of a similar nature which has a snap lock or other similar locking device thereon, without first having removed the door or the lock from said icebox, refrigerator or container. By-law 3709, August 23, 1962.

Article 2 - Enforcement

817.2.1 **Fine - for contravention**

Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Chapter is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine or penalty as provided in the *Provincial Offences Act*. By-law 7139-94, June 2, 1994.

Article 3 - Enactment

817.3.1 **Effective date**

The by-law upon which this Chapter is founded came into force and took effect upon the final passing thereof. By-law 3709, August 23, 1962.
