NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING REGARDING 2018 DEVELOPMENT CHARGES

Take notice that on Thursday, May 3rd, 2018 the Council of the City of Woodstock will hold a public meeting pursuant to the *Development Charges Act, 1997*, regarding proposed development charge rates and policies to be applied throughout the City. It is proposed that the enactment of a new development charge by-law by Council would occur on a date subsequent to the public meeting.

Development Charges are levied against new development and are a primary source of funding for growth-related capital expenditures. The 2018 Development Charges Background Study relates to the provision of the city-wide services of library, fire, police, parks and recreation, public works, waste management, transit, general government and roads and related services.

Council is required, under the *Development Charges Act, 1997*, to hold at least one public meeting to allow the public the opportunity to review and provide comments on the 2018 City of Woodstock Development Charges Background Study and the proposed Development Charges By-law.

The 2018 Development Charges Background Study and the proposed Development Charges By-law will be made available for review not later than 21 days in advance of the public meeting and may be obtained from the Clerk's office, 500 Dundas Street, or from the City's website at www.cityofwoodstock.ca.

Any person may attend the public meeting and make written or verbal representation either in support of or in opposition to the by-law. Written submissions are invited and should be directed to the undersigned. Written comments received prior to the meeting and submissions made at the public meeting will be considered by Council prior to the new development charge by-law. All submissions received will become part of a public record.
