


City of Woodstock
Norwich and Warwick Area Flooding Study
Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Schedule B)

Notice of Completion

Dillon Consulting Limited has been retained by the City of Woodstock to complete the Class Environmental Assessment (EA) to address flooding concerns in the Norwich and Warwick neighborhoods. On July 28th, 2010 areas within the City of Woodstock received 75-100mm of rainfall within a 4-hour period. As a result of the storm, portions of the City's sewer infrastructure became overwhelmed with surface water runoff and many basements in the Norwich and Warwick neighborhoods were flooded. Ongoing public concern has led the City of Woodstock to initiate this study to assess the cause and identify a preferred solution to mitigate the potential for future flooding in these areas (see attached map).



The project was conducted in compliance with Schedule 'B' of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment, which is an approved process under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act.

Taking into consideration the identification of the problem/opportunity, the assessment of the planning alternatives and design alternatives, comments received at the Public Information Centres and input from members of the public the Preferred Alternative for the Warwick area is Alternative 5 and for the Norwich area is Alternative 3. Both Alternatives are multi phase projects consisting of a combination of conveyance improvements, increases in storm water runoff storage volume and redirection of flows.
