

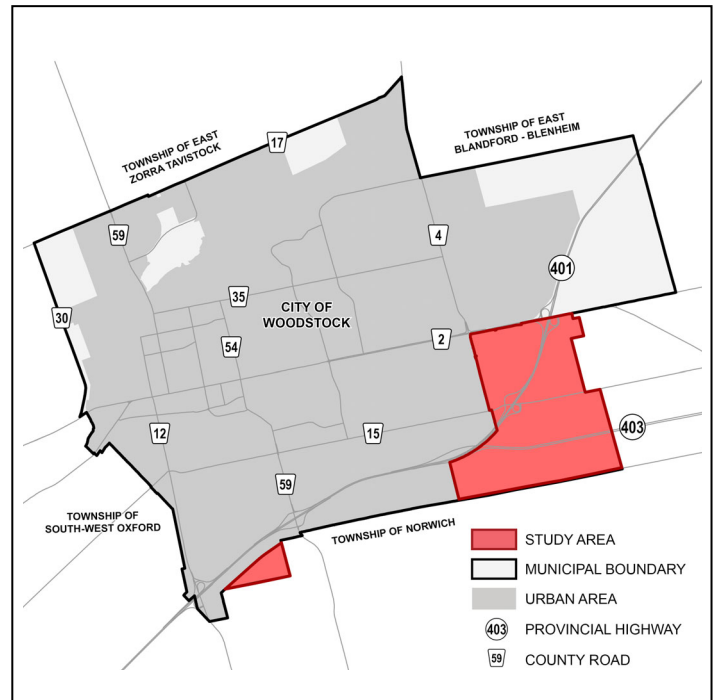
## Southeast Woodstock Settlement Expansion Justification, Secondary Plan and Servicing Strategy Including Transportation, Water, Wastewater and Stormwater Management Master Plans

### NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE #2

#### The Study

The City of Woodstock (the City) is completing a Secondary Plan and Servicing Strategy for the Southeast Urban Boundary Expansion Areas (see map).

The intent of the study is to provide a detailed land use plan and policies that will guide future development and address all infrastructure requirements for the land that was annexed by the City for future urban growth. The study is following Approach #4 of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Master Planning process which integrates the municipal servicing decision making with the Planning Act Secondary Plan process. The infrastructure master plan will address water and wastewater servicing as well as stormwater drainage. PIC #1 was held on May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2019 to introduce the project, present the preliminary land use concepts and to present the background study findings and servicing strategy considerations for wastewater, water, stormwater management and transportation.

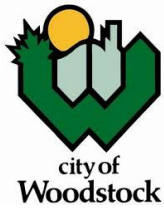


#### Public Information Centre #2 (PIC#2)
