NOTICE OF COMPLETION

Beards Lane Widening - Parkinson Road to Dundas Street Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Schedule B

The City of Woodstock has completed a Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) Study 'Schedule B' for the Widening of Beards Lane from Parkinson Road to Dundas Street (refer to Study Area below). Beards Lane is presently a two-lane road in an industrial area with significant truck traffic and movements. The study recommends Beards Lane be widened to a three-lane cross section with a shared left turn lane throughout the majority of the study area and that it be improved to a semi-urban cross section with curbs and gutters while maintaining a ditch on the west side of the road.

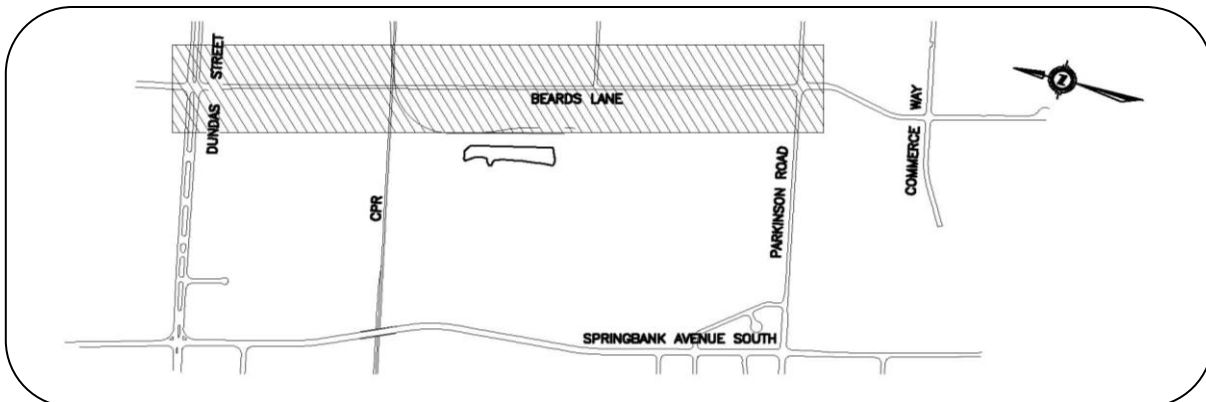
