Lampman Place Extension - Rideau Road to Juliana Drive Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Schedule B

The City of Woodstock has completed a Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) Study 'Schedule 'B' for the extension of Lampman Place from Rideau Road to Juliana Drive (refer to Study Area below).

The study is recommending a two-lane connection from the existing terminus of Lampman Place to Juliana Drive to minimize traffic strain on the existing neighborhood, allow for development of adjacent properties and improve emergency vehicle access to the area.

The second Public Information Centre (PIC#2) is scheduled for Wednesday, September 2, 2015. The project team will provide an overview of the recommended option and give stakeholders an opportunity for questions and comments following the presentation.

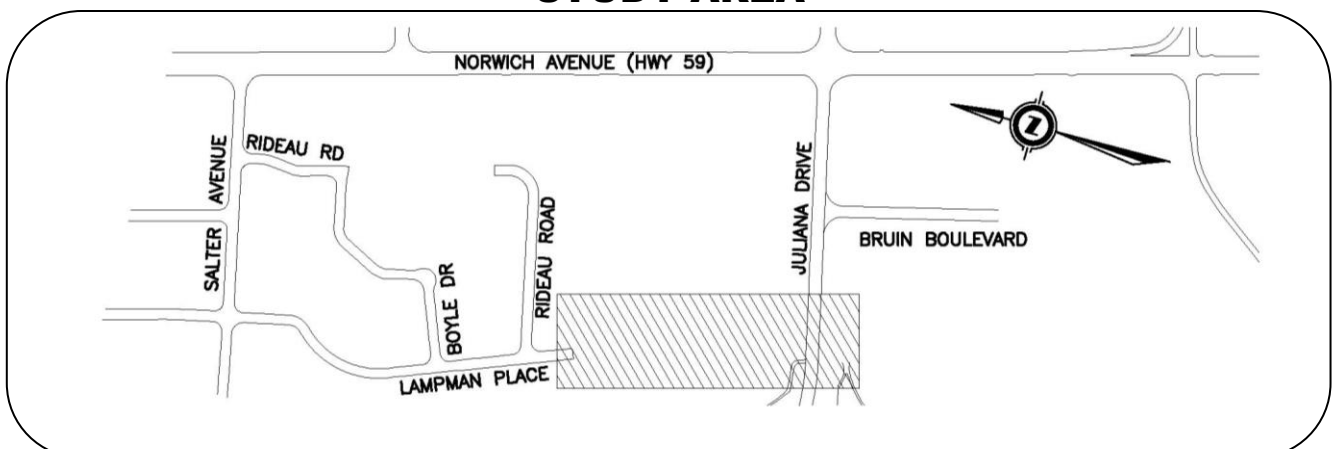
