



SOUTH SIDE WASTEWATER SERVICING STRATEGY MUNICIPAL CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT NOTICE OF PROCESS CLOSURE

The Study

In July 2017, the City of Woodstock (the City) and the County of Oxford (the County) initiated a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Master Plan study to investigate options for sanitary sewer *servicing of unserviced lands within the City*. The study's focus was on addressing near term and long term wastewater (sanitary sewage) servicing requirements in the south part of the City (see map).

The Process

Since the study's initiation, the need for near term wastewater servicing in the City's south wastewater collection system has been pushed back. As such, the City and County are formally suspending this Class EA study. Near term and long term wastewater servicing will be planned on a City-wide basis considering potential urban boundary expansion and wastewater service area boundaries through a future study.
