



Fee Assistance in Recreation (FAIR)

The FAIR program assist City of Woodstock residents living in low income with the opportunities to participate in recreation and leisure activities provided by the City.

- A credit will be placed on the City Recreation Legend account for families who qualify. The account will be good for 1 year and can be used on recreational city programs.

Who can apply?

To qualify you must meet the following criteria;

- Live in the City of Woodstock
- Have a family income that falls below the Low Income Cut-Off (LICO) for your family size. (See chart below)

| 2 people | \$30,625 |
| 3 people | \$37,650 |

More than 7 people, for each additional person, add \$6,628.

How to Apply

- Download and complete the Fee Assistance in Recreation (FAIR) Application Form, or complete the online application form
- Photocopy proof of residence (i.e. driver's license, property tax bill or utility bill)
- Photocopy last year's Canada Child Benefit (CCB) and Ontario Child Benefit (OCB) Notice
- If you are not able to find the CCB and OCB Notice, photocopy last year's Notice of Assessment from the Canadian Revenue Agency to cover the entire family. If you are not able to find last year's Notice of Assessment you can call the Canadian Revenue Agency at 1-800-959-8281 to obtain a copy of the "Income Tax Return"-Information Regular (which shows line 150)
- Place form and documentation in an envelope marked:
