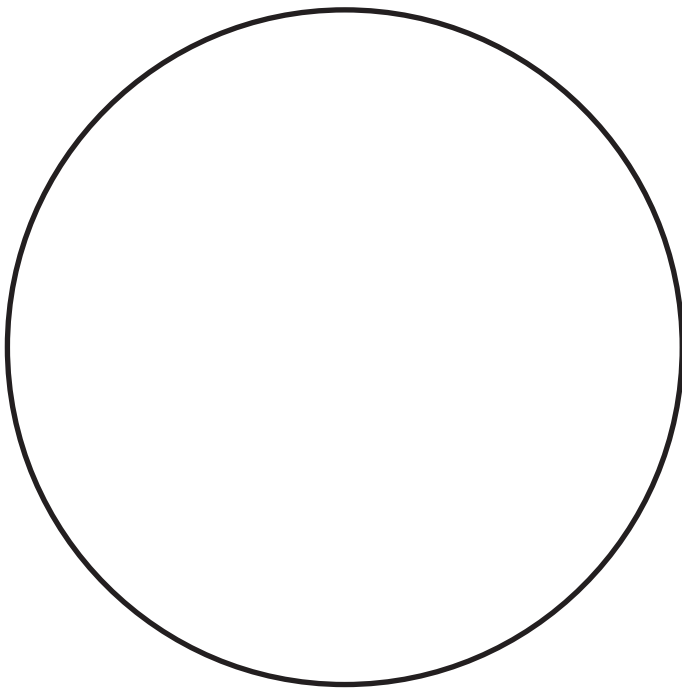
Design Your Sticker!
